

Standard Risk Control Arrangements

Mansell Operatives

(These Controls Are Also To Be Used When Agency or Other Operatives Are Used)

Training and Capability

- A. All Mansell employees must have received a minimum of a general induction covering the hazards of the Work Location.
- B. All Mansell employees must have received a “briefing” into the Risk Assessment and Method Statement (where the risk assessment determines one is necessary) for any hazardous activities.
- C. The Supervisors of Mansell employees must have received adequate training (at least 1 day each 3 years).
- D. Mansell employees must receive a one-day Safety course (every 5 years).
- E. Mansell employees must hold a relevant CSCS card for their trade and a Mansell Passport to Work.
- F. All personnel who could likely disturb asbestos while carrying out their work, or who may influence how work is carried out on a Mansell project, will have undergone asbestos awareness training through a provider who has signed up to the Asbestos Training Providers Code of Conduct (verified by holding code of conduct certification containing the ATPR and HSE code of conduct logo).

Control Arrangements

- G. Employees working on activities identified as having significant risk are working in line with the defined controls
- H. Employees are to use hazardous materials in line with CoSHH Assessments available from Sypol and held in the on site CoSHH File
- I. Employees are protected from noisy areas of operation in line with Noise Assessments (SM-FM-39)
- J. Employees are not manual handling any object that could cause harm (especially over 25kg) without a Manual Handling Assessment (SM-FM-37)
- K. Relevant posters and signs are available that visually highlight the main areas of risk of Safety and Environmental matters (from Work Activity Schedule)
- L. A safe place of work is provided at all times (as per SRCA 12 and 20)
- M. All hand tools are in good repair
- N. Personal protective equipment (PPE) is being worn correctly. (as per SRCA 10)
- O. Clothing has no loose ends and is clean to prevent Dermatitis
- P. Young persons (under 18) will work under strict Risk Assessment Controls and supervision (see SRCA 69).
- Q. Children (under school leaving age) will work under strict Risk Assessment Controls and supervision, and the child’s parents or guardian will receive copies of the Risk Assessments (see SRCA 69).
- R. Pregnant workers and Nursing Mothers will work under strict Risk Assessment controls (see SRCA 69).
